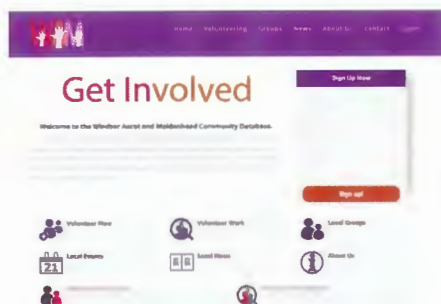
New service for the Voluntary Sector in Windsor, Ascot and Maidenhead
