A busy Summer

Summer of 2018 brought many new visitors to Broomhall Lane Recreation Ground to enjoy the warm weather with picnics and games on the field, hours spent digging in the sand pit, playing in the park or enjoying the space with their “faithful companions”. Our tennis courts were also kept busy with many bookings each day - August being the busiest month of all.

Elsewhere, the council continued to improve the environment around the village. The hanging baskets put on a bountiful display and work on the flower beds on London Road and Chobham Road added to the existing planting scheme to complement and refresh.

Work took place by the RBWM Footpath team and the Parish Grounds team to cut back the overgrowth along the Bridleway of Kiln Lane leading to the cemetery where further work will be taking place on the entrance and pathways.

Our allotment holders kept their crops growing through our sunny summer, watering daily in many cases. The William Pack Cup for the best allotment has been judged and the winners will feature in our November issue.



The Planning Committee of council diligently reviewed and commented on over 96 applications on behalf of the parish during the summer months, along with representations at the Windsor Rural Development Control Panel on applications which the committee and many of our residents objected to.

Looking forward to the Autumn

The Parish Council will once again be organising the winter bloom baskets. There may not be as many as in the summer, however they still brighten up the village during the winter months.

Our Christmas celebration will add the lights which will be switched on at 7pm on Friday 30th November – so save the date and more information will come in the November issue.

New signage at the Recreation Ground is due in the autumn, helping visitors to safely

use the park. We understand the frustrations when information changes, however be assured changes are only made at the instruction of our regular safety inspectors and are there to keep you and your loved ones safe.
