(T1) Beech - crown lift the tree to obtain at least 5 metres ground clearance all around the base of the tree and further tip reduce the entire crown by approximately 1.5 - 2 metres (this will take the tree height from 15 metres to 13 metres and the width from 18 metres to 16.5 metres).

It is unfortunate that there is no arboricultural report and no photographs to support the proposed crown lifting and tip reduction of the beech tree.

However, as can be seen from the photographs shown below taken by the Parish Council in October 2020 this tree is in a very prominent and public position within Sunningdale.

It is noted that the approved 2011 application for works on this same tree proposed a crown lift to 4m whereas a 5m crown lift is now proposed.





The Parish Council **refers this application to the Tree Officer** to confirm the appropriate crown lift and tip reduction which might satisfy the inhabitants of The Ambassador yet at the same time preserve the appearance of this TPO beech tree for the public.
