The Parish Council had anticipated seeing supportive photographic evidence as this is a retrospective application for two substantial marquees, situated in a prominent position on the terraces of two houses.

The purpose of the marquees is not defined, and it is also not clear how they would sit comfortably alongside this listed building which is of significant local historical merit.

Only outline drawings of the marquees are included in the application. It is difficult to visualise how the two rectangular shaped canvas covered steel framed marquees would '*blend in with the Portland stone wall cladding and terrace*' as claimed in the application. They measure 6.7 metres x 4 metres and 5.5 metres x 4 metres in size and at 2.9 metres high they are substantial structures.

The Parish Council can therefore only visualise a tent like structure that is neither defined as temporary or permanent and is likely, like many canvas structures, to become tired in appearance over time.

As the outlook from the buildings is over grassland the Parish Council would have thought that approval of these terraces would detract visually from the overall appearance of the listed building.

We recommend that this application is **Refused**.
