Many thanks to those of you who took part in the survey we conducted in December last year. Your feedback will help us focus on the things that matter to you.

- We put a lot of effort into making sure that the recreation ground is in a safe and welcoming environment for all
 our visitors. It is heartening to know that more than half the respondents were satisfied with the recreation
 ground as a whole supported by comments such as 'Broomhall is a fabulous community hub' and 'Recreation
 ground is an excellent facility for families'
- There is a 50:50 split between residents who feel involved in village life and those who don't. In the
 questionnaire, we asked how you found out about what is going on in the village, to which the majority said they
 relied on word of mouth, followed closely by free publications.
- We also gathered feedback about the services provided by the Royal Borough. Satisfaction with the condition
 of roads, public footpaths and the management of roadside verges was low.

Our next step is to analyse the data more fully to identify all the areas where we need to make improvements.

In fact, one of the first things we need to do is to change the way we communicate with you so that we can get information to you direct. This will involve gathering e-mail addresses and we'll let you know how we are going to do this at a later date.
