



Recycling in Sunningdale

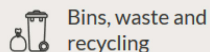
The recycling centre in the London Road Car Park has become an area used more for the dumping of general rubbish rather than for its purpose of recycling. Over the last few years the Parish Council has worked with RBWM and contractors to attempt to find a way in which this problem could be solved.

Despite repeated additional visits by the cleansing contractors and waste companies, this problem has persisted. Therefore, the decision has been taken by the team at RBWM and supported by the Parish Council to remove this site.

So how to recycle from now on?

RBWM provide road side recycling to the village of Sunningdale with the added incentive of participating in the [Green Redeem Scheme](#) which rewards residents for recycling.

The more you recycle the more points you can earn



Recycling points can either be:

- Redeemed in a variety of shops and businesses,
- Donated to local good causes,
- Used in a monthly prize draw.

How the scheme works:

- Wheeler bins are weighed as they are emptied,
- Weights are turned into recycling points.

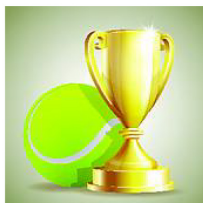

- Family Memberships includes up to 2 Adults and 4 Children aged 5 – 17 years inclusive: £70.50 per family with an additional £10 key deposit
- Adult Memberships: £35.50 per person with an additional £10 key deposit
- Junior Memberships for 5 – 17 years inclusive: £17.50 per person with an additional £10 key deposit
- Senior Memberships are available for 60 + years: £26.50 per person with an additional £10 key deposit
