Maintenance of the memorial is the responsibility of the owner/applicant. All memorials in Kiln Lane Cemetery will be subject to a minimum five-yearly inspection by the Parish Council and any defects reported with regard stability should be corrected at the owner's cost. Under product liability law a memorial should remain 'fit for purpose' for at least 6 years, in the circumstance that cement fails the mason has a duty to repair.

I have been instructed by the said person above to carry out the above work in accordance with Sunningdale Parish Council's Regulations and Guidelines and to conform to the National Association of Memorial Masons or British Register of Accredited Memorial Masons, Code of working practice and BS 8415 specification for Memorials & Monuments in Burial Grounds. I agree to pay to make good any damage I, or anyone working in my employ, might cause.

A diagram and details of design and dimensions of the memorial are attached. The memorial will not be installed until the Council's permission is received and 48 hours notification of installation is given.
