Safer Streets Proposal

In Sunningdale Parish, the Safer Streets proposal includes several initiatives which together will help make local streets safer for everyone.

- 1. Proposed 20mph in selective roads with vulnerable road users (see list and maps below)
- 2. "Gateway" signs upon entry to 20mph zones and 20mph markers within the zone
- 3. Improved summer maintenance of existing footpaths
- 4. Renovation of Bridleway / PROW from A30 to Coworth Park
- 5. Better maintenance of speed limit signs on A30
- 6. Improve safety of parking in vicinity of Pelican Crossing on A30 (near Dominos)
- 7. Actions to reduce vehicles crossing wrong side of Zebra Crossing on A30 (near Waitrose)
- 8. Pedestrian crossing on Rise Road close to proposed new Medical Centre
- 9. Traffic light-controlled access through Dry Arch Road to protect pedestrians and cyclists

In Sunningdale Parish Council, the core of the proposal are roads which received significant nominations from the community. These form, in the main, a clear integrated zone around the Old Village.

All the roads meet the following criteria:

- Narrow road and / or a narrow pavement or no pavement at all, despite a mix of vehicles and vulnerable road users.
- No alternative method of separating vulnerable road users due to the village environment with houses preventing creation of wider pavements.
- These roads connect and form the major routes to / from schools, churches, village hall, recreation ground, doctors' surgery / new medical centre.
- For reasons of logic and simplicity as well as easier signage, roads fully enclosed by the roads noted would also adopt 20mph for simplicity to create a coherent cluster or zone, minimising speed limit changes and strengthening compliance.

The proposed 20mph roads are:



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
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
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Joint Sunningdale Parish Council & Sunninghill & Ascot Parish council Map
