



Help make our streets safer for everyone

In September / October 2022, the parishes of Sunninghill and Ascot, and Sunningdale carried out a joint survey for "Safer Streets", looking at the simplest, easiest, and most cost-effective way of improving safety for all road users. In particular, support of 20 mph on selected roads and other ideas to make our streets safer.

- 272 People responded to the survey
- 81% were in support of 20 mph on selected roads
- 657 specific road nominations were received
- 139 additional comments including suggested roads

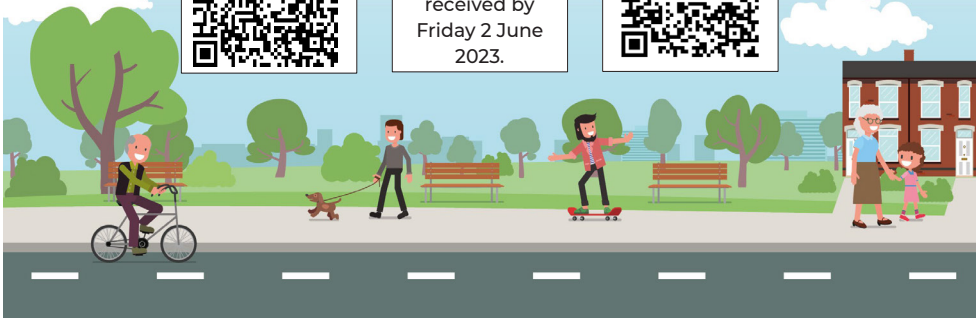

The plan for the weekend is:

Saturday 6th May – The Coronation Service

Sunday 7th May – The Coronation Concert and Big Lunch

A special Coronation Concert will take place at Windsor Castle. Produced, staged and broadcast live by the BBC and BBC Studios. Neighbours and communities across the United Kingdom are invited to share food and fun together at Coronation Big Lunches in a nationwide act of community, celebration, and friendship. From a cup of tea with a neighbour to a street party, and as an alternative to a street party, the field at Broomhall Recreation Ground will be available.
