Broomhall Recreation Ground Update

Following the Resident Survey which was carried out last year numerous CIL (Community Infrastructure Levy) projects are being considered and completed by the Recreation Ground Working Group. These projects include:

- Re-Designing the Car Park. The existing car park can become extremely busy and congested during peak periods. A car park planning feasibility survey is soon to be carried out to advise how the Parish Council can enhance and improve utilisation of the space.
- Outdoor Fitness Equipment. Following the removal of the end-of-life outdoor fitness equipment last year the budget has now been agreed for new equipment, and this will be installed during the Summer.
- Flooding and Safety Works to the Stream. Flooding has been a problem on the bend of Broomhall Lane due to the stream becoming blocked. A grate has been installed by the bridge to help eliminate debris becoming wedged underneath the bridge.



Local CIL Grant Funding

The Parish Council have awarded the 'Save the Novello Picture House' project with funding of £100,000 to support their renovation works. The theatre has been underused and poorly maintained for many years. Following the renovation works the theatre will be returned to the local community of Sunninghill and Sunningdale enabling the charity to meet currently unfulfilled demand for purpose-built performance space.



The Parish Council have also awarded the 'Transforming Trinity' Project with funding of £84,697 to support the re-ordering and refurbishment of Holy Trinity to enable the church to be used as a community hub. The funds will specifically support the new servery, furniture for the café space and the renewal of the drive and pathway.
