Over the last few months, we have had an increasing number of calls and emails from residents with questions about verges; ditches; road cleaning; pavement sweeping; trees; litter; missing manholes; potholes and much more!

Whilst the Parish Council is always happy to help, we thought it may be helpful to provide the information on what to do and how to report these issues so that they are fixed.

Waste Collections – Missed bins – Textile Collections.

Trees, Hedges, Grass Cutting Overhanging Trees – verges not cut – neighbour disputes.

Roads. Pavements, Footpaths Flooding – missing manholes – flyposting – graffiti – road marking – street cleaning – traffic lights – litter – street lighting – Public Rights of Way

Parking Enforcement for cars parked illegally.

Environmental Services Anti-Social Behaviour – Food premises licences and issues – noise – smoke – animal welfare.

Services around the village provided by the Parish Council

Apart from managing the day-to-day work for the recreation ground, including the tennis courts and playgrounds, the Parish Council maintain different areas of the village:

- The Allotment gardens on Church Road.
- The planters around Chobham Road shops and planter benches by the parking area.
- Bloom baskets during the year including the large tubs in the middle of the A30.
- The bus shelters which are cleaned every month.
- Benches around the village.
- The clock in the centre of the village.
- The war memorial and the maintenance of the Holy Trinity Graveyard.
- Kiln Lane Cemetery.
- The defibrillators around the village.
- The dog bins around the village.
- The salt bins around the village.
- The telephone box book exchange on Chobham Road and the children's telephone box book exchange at Broomhall Recreation Ground.
- Broomhall Recreation Ground brook, woodland and path through the woodland.
