## Parish Council Precept for 2026-2027

You will have received your Council Tax demand for the financial year 2026-2027 from RBWM which includes the separate parish precept for Sunningdale Parish Council. The Parish Council are pleased to announce that the precept remains unchanged, at the same level as 2025-2026.

For the year April 2026 to March 2027, the precept will stay at £260,811. This is equivalent to a Band D household charge of £67.92 per annum, which is actually a reduction of £1.73 from the previous year - due to an increase in the tax base.

The Council is conscious of the increase in the cost of living which all homes are experiencing.

The table below shows the **annual** precept charge per household for 2026-2027 for each Council Tax band.

**The Council is pleased to report a balanced budget.**

**Total income**, excluding the precept and CIL receipts, is forecasted at £184,352

**Total expenditure**, excluding CIL-funded items, is estimated at £445,163 but includes a transfer to reserves of £39,902 net, resulting in net expenditure of £405,261.

The Council continues to benefit from, the **Community Infrastructure Levy** (“CIL”) on major property developments taking place locally.

In the financial year 2025-2026, Council has used CIL receipts to fund the adult fitness equipment, Children’s Book Exchange and deer fence at the allotments.

The council has received several CIL Stakeholder Grant applications and are delighted to report that requests from Novello Picture House, Sunningdale Scout Hut, Berks County Football and Holy Trinity Church were approved.

Projects in the discussion phase due to be funded from CIL include, but not limited to,

- Broomhall Recreation Ground car park upgrade
- Padel courts
- Coffee chalet
- Gates for the allotments
- Gates for Broomhall Recreation Ground
- Tennis net dividers
- Kiln Lane cemetery extension

The Council hosted for the first time, the Open-Air Cinema which was a great success and the Cancer Research Fund raising event Sip Sip Hooray.

Bouncy Fun days and the Christmas Switch On event will continue to be organised to foster community engagement.

Last but not least, the views of residents inform the decisions the council takes and are at the heart of the policies that are developed. The Parish Council look forward to hearing from the community and encourage all residents to take the opportunity to share your thoughts on how the village can work together to make Sunningdale a place people want to live, work, and play in.
