Dear Resident

To continue with the construction of the new Holloway Hill / Green Lane Roundabout, we need to close the below sections of Holloway Hill and Hardwick Lane, as can be seen on the below graphic.



The roads will be closed 24 hours a day for approximately 6 months from **Tuesday 14th April**, there will be no through route / access for any vehicles.

A signed diversion route will be in place via:

- Guildford Road,

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- Chobham Road,
- Old Chertsey Road,
- Stonehill Road
- Return to Holloway Hill

To reach Hardwick Lane, please continue on the diversion route via:

- Longcross Road,
- Lyne Lane,
- Return to Hardwick Lane

A signed pedestrian diversion will be in place via Stonehill Road, Foxhills Road, and Guildford Road.

The closure will enable our team to construct the western edge of the new roundabout, away from live traffic. A full closure of the road is required as we will be demolishing the existing road, and replacing it with a new road alignment, along with new drainage culverts below the road's surface.

The new roundabout is expected to be complete in full in Spring 2027 and will see the abolishment of the two mini-roundabouts on Guildford Road, with them being replaced by a new larger roundabout.
